Subject: Learning opportunity –World Tour Montréal

In collaboration with the World Tour organizing committee, the FQSC and the Canadian Cycling Association we are pleased to provide this unique development opportunity for our commissaires.

Development opportunity

Recently, the UCI investigated the type of continuing training that is most appropriate for its officials. After much research of many sports bodies, the UCI selected the “Multisport training for Quebec Officials (MTQO)”. This program was chosen as it was developed by experts with an in-depth knowledge of the environment in which officials operate as well as sport in general. The program is composed of eight training modules which **five of them will be mandatory for all International Commissaires who wish to continue their officials UCI activities.**

Of the program’s five mandatory training modules, we will be able to deliver one module (3hrs) on the Saturday September 10th in Montréal. This is a unique opportunity as most of the workshop will be delivered in Aigle, Switzerland.

Hélène Soulard, a UCI recognized leader for the MTQO workshop will deliver the “Decision Making” module.
